#### WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE BLACK LABEL CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2019

"The 64th vintage. A wine of provenance. A wine of excellence. It ages superbly, yet is flattering when young... This is up there as one of the finest to date. Bravo." 97 points, Halliday Wine Companion

A fresh and inviting aroma of red and black cherries is lifted by notes of dried mint and fresh violets. Flavours of red cherry and plum are complemented by the secondary notes of walnuts and mixed cooking spice. Very intense yet elegant, with a nose of pure Cabernet fruit.

#### WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE V&A CABERNET SHIRAZ 2019

"It's medium bodied (just) and the tannins are gossamer-fine, yet spun together to a gentle hold. Compelling wine." 95 points, Halliday Wine Companion

Dark brambly fruits are layered with black tea, aniseed and peppery spices. Velvety tannin creates depth and is defined by crisp acidity and beautiful line, leaving the palate full and long with a smoky, gravelly finish. Mulberry, blackberry and blood orange with subtle nutty and black spice notes.

#### WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE V&A SHIRAZ 2019

"This a wine of finesse. Certainly flavoursome, with its puff of perfume and spicy red and black plums infused with Pontefrac licorice. A very good V&A Lane Shiraz."

Bright cherry and blueberry complement more savoury elements of stalks, pastry, and spice. There is a light yet expansive quality to the palate. The pure fruits give way to lingering crushed pepper and cinnamon on the finish. Lifted cranberry, magnolia flower and fresh pastry notes.

### WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE JOHNSON'S BLOCK CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2018

"There's an opulence to the 2018 vintage reds and yet Wynns always manages to coat the wines with a layer of elegance. It's all about precision, from a core of ripe fruit, its length to beautifully shaped silk-coated tannins."

Floral and distinctive, this wine showcases the Johnson's Block terroir at its best. The palate is lively and jubilant with a cool acidity that drives a long finish. The essence of crunchy red fruits – redcurrants and strawberry notes with a hint of red roses. Fresh and decadent, but not cloying.

#### WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE MICHAEL SHIRAZ 2018

The 2021 Wynnsday Collection has arrived! Spanning two exceptional vintages, this release brings with it the return of Wynns' flagship wines, the John Riddoch Cabernet Sauvignon and Michael Shiraz. These wines are only made from the very best parcels in the very best vintages, and 2018 was certainly that.

Ample rainfall during the winter and a long summer ensured yields were moderate, and a perfectly cool ripening period produced high-quality fruit with fine tannins and clear varietal characters, making exceptional wines. The 2019 vintage was equally lauded – the wines are more elegant and provide an excellent and worthy contrast to those from 2018.

Each vintage, Wynns releases a single-vineyard wine to highlight a block that has performed particularly well. This Wynnsday it was the Johnson's Block. Planted in 1954, it is the oldest surviving Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard in Coonawarra, making wines that are fine, aromatic and dark-fruited, with a cool acidity that provides a long finish.

The 2021 Wynnsday release also features two wines from the V&A range, the Shiraz and the Cabernet Shiraz. These wines come from a



particular patch of Coonawarra's famed terra rossa strip that ripens early, and the resulting wines are fresh, bright and harmonious, with plenty of complexity.

Finally, no Wynnsday collection would be complete without the Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon, and the 2019 vintage is exemplary of the range, providing freshness, balance and power. Like all of the wines in this release, it will reward careful cellaring.
