The Region: Clare Valley, SA

The Aromatics: Floral aromas of spring blossoms combined with fresh lemon, lime, and underlying minerality deliver a fresh bouquet.

The Flavours: This classic Clare Valley Riesling boasts pure, fresh and clean fruit flavours. The mouth-watering palate is enhanced by limes and a talcy texture delivering a crisp finish.

The Aromatics: Notes of lemon curd, nougat and white flowers shine before underlying subtle French oak spice. The bouquet is pure and refined, yet powerful in fruit intensity.

The Flavours: Classic characters of lemon curd and citrus rind are supported by underlying nougat and mineral slate. The palate is fine, pure and long and finishes with juicy, pithy citrus acidity.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2027

LITTLE BERRY PADTHAWAY PINOT GRIGIO 2019

The Region: Padthaway, SA

The Aromatics: The zesty bouquet shows an abundance of classic Pinot Grigio aromatics – nashi pear, spicy citrus and a hint of freshly crushed ginger.

The Flavours: The palate is fresh and crisp with lovely mineral texture, white nectarine and a herbaceous touch, before finishing with succulent acidity.

The Longevity: Enjoy now

SEPPELT GRUNER VELTLINER 2018

The Region: Henty, VIC

The Aromatics: Aromas of sweet spice and peppercorns with pears and green apple fill the glass with fresh yet warming bouquet.

The Flavours: Spiced pears and citrus combine with textural elements and fine, chalky acidity for a fresh and full wine.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2030

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MATUA REGIONAL MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC 2019

The Region: Marlborough, NZ

The Aromatics: The fragrant bouquet is bursting with pure citrus notes enhanced by hints of grapefruit and basil.

The Flavours: The fresh and vibrant palate dazzles with concentrated blackcurrant leaf, a hint of nettle and green melon for a deliciously refreshing wine.

DEVIL'S LAIR THE HIDDEN CAVE SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018

The Region: Margaret River, WA

The Aromatics: This engaging and complex wine reveals intense citrus, orange blossom and nettle combine to deliver a fragrant and alluring aroma with a touch of subtle spice and mineral notes.

The Flavours: Zesty Sauvignon Blanc nettles, lemon peel, kiwifruit and passionfruit are superbly supported by a juicy textural core of lime and passionfruit provided by the Semillon.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2021

BAILEYS OF Glenrowan Shiraz 2014

The Region: Glenrowan, VIC

The Aromatics: Ripe red cherries and raspberries fill the glass with a perfumed potpourri lift delivering a fresh and fruity bouquet.

The Flavours: This is a fresh yet fullbodied Shiraz bursting with blueberries, boysenberries, sweet liquorice and plums. Seasoned French oak and good tannins round out the moreish palate.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2021

ST HUBERTS YARRA VALLEY CABERNET MERLOT 2016

The Region: Yarra Valley, VIC

The Aromatics: Brooding dark fruits, hints of black olives and liquorice, with classic Cabernet cassis combining for an intense bouquet.

The Flavours: The wine is mediumbodied, vibrant and balanced. A soft and fleshy palate displays cassis, plum, cedar and spice flavours. Restrained oak and soft tannins frame the wine beautifully.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2023

We love this wine with... Roast shoulder of lamb



JIIIKAL ZUI

The Region: Barossa Valley, SA

The Aromatics: Rich dark red and blue fruits, ripe blackberries, dark chocolate and rich mocha notes are enveloped by hints of spice and integrated oak for a rich and elegant bouquet.

The Flavours: This is a rich and plush Barossa Shiraz with concentrated layers of blackberry, blue fruits and oak, balanced with soft layers of tannins giving length and finesse.

The Longevity: Enjoy now

SQUEALING PIG CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT NOIR 2018

The Region: Marlborough, NZ

The Aromatics: Fresh blackberries and savoury spices combine to deliver a rich and earthy Pinot Noir bouquet.

The Flavours: The rich and full palate is bursting with blackberries and cherries, framed by savoury oak. Hints of wild rosemary and dried sage are in harmony with the delicate tannins.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2023

INGOLDBY MCLAREN VALE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017

The Region: McLaren Vale, SA

The Aromatics: The vibrant bouquet emanates with raspberries and blueberries supported by strong undertones of mint and dried eucalyptus leaves.

The Flavours: The intense and powerful palate balances cherries with smooth tannins, while secondary characters deliver excellent length.

The Longevity: Enjoy now

WOLF BLASS GREY LABEL LANGHORNE CREEK CABERNET SHIRAZ 2017

The Region: Langhorne Creek, SA

The Aromatics: The nose is all rich and dark fruits bursting with black cherries and cassis, complexed with subtle mineral notes and savoury oak.

The Flavours: Layers of black and red berries, mineral nuances, warm spice and subtle savoury oak envelop the palate. The wine boasts richness yet finesse, lengthened by finely textured tannins.

The Longevity: Enjoy now

GETTING TO KNOW GLENROWAN

Glenrowan may be most famous for its association with Ned Kelly, but bushrangers aside, the town is also renowned for its bold and complex wines – rather like the legend of Mr Kelly himself.

Glenrowan is one of Victoria's most historic wine regions with 13 growers and seven cellar doors calling this tiny pocket of the northeastern Victoria high country home. Production dates back to 1870, with the famous Bailey family. Their fortified wines flourished in the rich red granite soils, ensuring the wines of Glenrowan made their name both domestically and as highly sought-after for export.

The tiny region was devastated by phylloxera at the turn of the 20th Century. Although small, the residents of Glenrowan were mighty and resilient, re-planting with disease-resistant rootstock. As a result of their hard work, today some of Australia's greatest dessert style wines hail from Glenrowan – notably their powerful Muscats and Tokays. Glenrowan Shiraz also makes a worthy name thanks to the winemaking and viticulture talent making the most of the fruit on its fertile ranges.

If you're seeking out powerful red wines and globally acclaimed fortifieds, then look no further than Glenrowan – a tiny region that packs a mighty punch when it comes to outstanding wines.
