WOLF BLASS WHITE LABEL PICCADILLY VALLEY CHARDONNAY 2017

The Region: Piccadilly Valley, SA

The Aromatics: The fresh, complex nose invites with stone fruit, peach and nectarine aromas with hints of citrus. Subtle nutty oak is present, yet seamlessly integrated.

The Flavours: The elegant and focused palate boasts impeccable balance. A fine acid line allows flavours to build, persist and complete the wine with a tight finish and exceptional length.

The Region: Yarra Valley, VIC

The Region: Clare Valley, SA

The Region: Marlborough, NZ

MARLBOROUGH - MUCH MORE THAN SAUVIGNON BLANC

More than 140 years ago, a diverse landscape on the top of New Zealand's South Island was planted with vines that began to flourish in the unique terroir. More than half a century later, brothers Bill and Ross Spence from Matua Wines produced New Zealand's first commercial Sauvignon Blanc and changed the reputation of the style.

Unique soils, crisp nights and sun-kissed days bless the region the Māori refer to as “Kei puta te Wairau” (the place with the hole in the cloud) – characteristics that ensure the vibrancy and intensity of flavours and aromatics, and appealing balanced acidity that the region is now renowned for.

Responsible for over 86 per cent of Marlborough's fruit, Sauvignon Blanc is the region's workhorse. While this pungently aromatic, pure, herbaceous, tropical and mineral style makes Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc an international brand, there is so much more to Marlborough.

The region's Pinot Noir is building its status as local growers refine both clones and sites to deliver wines that are bursting with cherries and plums and spicy red fruits – giving the more famed Central Otago a run for their money in mastering this fickle grape.

Intense and complex Chardonnay saddled with stone fruits and citrus are also doing great things, while a wonderful range of aromatic varieties like Riesling, Pinot Gris and Gewürztraminer deliver a full spectrum of style including late harvest and botrytised wines. And the varieties to watch? Grüner Veltliner, Viognier and Syrah.

With more than 120 different wineries to choose from in the region, you'll be hard pressed to go past the perfect local accompaniments – the fresh seafood from the deep, clean waters

of the Marlborough Sounds including greenshell mussels, king salmon, Pacific oysters, abalone, kingfish and crayfish.

Our Regional Collections include Marlborough wines that really showcase the power and purity of the region's viticulture and winemaking prowess – and are the perfect opportunity to discover or rediscover the extraordinary flavours of Marlborough.
