LEO BURING CLARE VALLEY DRY RIESLING 2019

The Region: Clare Valley, SA

The Aromatics: Floral aromas of spring blossoms combined with fresh lemon, lime, and underlying minerality deliver a fresh bouquet.

The Flavours: This classic Clare Valley Riesling boasts pure, fresh and clean fruit flavours. The mouth-watering palate is enhanced by limes and a talc texture delivering a crisp finish.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2023

The Region: Yarra Valley, VIC

The Aromatics: Notes of lemon curd, nougat and white flowers shine before underlying subtle French oak spice. The bouquet is pure and refined, yet powerful in fruit intensity.

The Flavours: Classic characters of lemon curd and citrus rind are supported by underlying nougat and mineral slate. The palate is fine, pure and long and finishes with juicy, pithy citrus acidity.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2027

The Region: Padthaway, SA

The Aromatics: The zesty bouquet shows an abundance of classic Pinot Grigio aromatics – nashi pear, spicy citrus and a hint of freshly crushed ginger.

The Flavours: The palate is fresh and crisp with lovely mineral texture, white nectarine and a herbaceous touch, before finishing with succulent acidity.

The Region: Henty, VIC

The Region: Marlborough, NZ

The Aromatics: The fragrant bouquet is bursting with pure citrus notes enhanced by hints of grapefruit and basil.

The Flavours: The fresh and vibrant palate dazzles with concentrated blackcurrant leaf, a hint of nettle and green melon for a deliciously refreshing wine.

DEVIL'S LAIR THE HIDDEN CAVE SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018

The Region: Margaret River, WA

The Aromatics: This engaging and complex wine reveals intense citrus, orange blossom and nettle combine to deliver a fragrant and alluring aroma with a touch of subtle spice and mineral notes.

The Flavours: Zesty Sauvignon Blanc nettles, lemon peel, kiwifruit and passionfruit are superbly supported by a juicy textural core of lime and passionfruit provided by the Semillon.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2021

CALLING INTO THE CLARE VALLEY

South Australia's stunning Clare Valley is an enigma. Its ability to produce full-bodied reds and delicately crisp and floral dry Rieslings under a continental climate makes it famous for wines of intensity and balance (its secret is cool afternoon breezes to slow down ripening).

The Clare Valley is nestled among the northern Mt Lofty Ranges and was settled in the late-1830s. The first vineyards were planted, and wines produced, just a decade later making it one of Australia's oldest wine regions. Today some of Clare's most outstanding wines hail from Watervale and Polish Hill River.

The Clare Valley and Riesling go hand-in-hand – it is renowned for producing some of the very best in the country. In fact, as Huon Hooke states, “there is no greater name in Australian Riesling than Leo Buring” and we couldn't agree more. The brand's namesake Leo Buring (1876-1961) is one of the most important legacy figures of Australian wine,

and today the winery only produces Riesling – including outstanding examples showcasing the Clare.

Call into the Clare Valley by meandering through the region's 35-kilometre Riesling Trail. But don't miss out on Clare reds either – especially its Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon – they are as enticingly beautiful as its patchworked landscape you'll pass by. If you can't get there in person, then discover the Clare Valley with a local Riesling – you'll be transported there with just a glass.
