WYNNS JOHN RIDDOCH CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016

The Region: Coonawarra

The Aromatics: Pure, focused and refined. Beautifully balanced acidity and freshness ensure that this wine will live gracefully for 30 years.

The Flavours: It is all about cellarworthy cassis flavours combining with a mocha creaminess from French oak. Beautifully textured with a fine tannin line, this is why small batch winemaking is truly exceptional in its results.

The Longevity: Now - 2039



WYNNS MICHAEL Shiraz 2016

The Region: Coonawarra

The Aromatics: Invitingly floral with lifted red roses and hints of black pepper against a background of pure red berries.

The Flavours: Concentrated, crunchy berry fruit which is brooding yet enticing. Dusty French oak underlines juicy red fruit. As a young wine, we could already appreciate the silky fruit and texture that will develop further with time.

The Aromatics: Fresh lavender and mint combine with liquorice and crushed blackberries for an enticing bouquet.

The Flavours: An exquisite expression of classic Bordeaux varieties on the palate. Yet the unmistakable terra rossa flavours also pervade – dried mint with lavender and pleasing ubiquitous red cherry flavours.

WYNNS V&A LANE CABERNET SHIRAZ 2016

The Aromatics: Dark brambly fruits are layered with smoky black tea fragrances.

The Flavours: Co-fermentation of the two varieties creates a rich and textured wine with unique tannin structure, crisp acidity and a beautiful line.

WYNNS V&A LANE SHIRAZ 2012 The Region: Coonawarra

The Aromatics: A freshly baked rhubarb and blueberry pie made with flaky pastry. Blueberry, lifted by elegant dandelion and magnolia florals with hints of scented spice.

The Flavours: A modern wine with a fresh, structural palate. Whole bunch fermentation produces an attractive light structure and subtle hints of spice provide layered complexity. Drawn out by silky tannins and succulent acidity it finishes with a touch of minerality.

The Longevity: Now - 2028



WYNNS BLACK LABEL CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017

The Region: Coonawarra

The Aromatics: Opens with a perfume of leaf, black olives and dark cherries.

The Flavours: Vintage 2017 gave us spicier Cabernet flavours complementary to the smoky barbeque notes, but the Black Label pedigree remains with persistent dark cherries and fine tannins.

WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE NEW VINTAGE RELEASES

Wynnsday 2019 marks a bold new chapter in the Wynns story, featuring the 62nd vintage of Black Label Cabernet and the first Single Vineyard O'Deas Red Blend.

As a result of a warm and dry 2016 vintage, this release of our John Riddoch Cabernet Sauvignon and Michael Shiraz both sit on the fuller end of the flavour and style spectrums. Yet, with complexity and depth of flavour these wines are unmistakably "Wynns". 2017, on the other hand, presented a cool growing season with late rain leading to leaner red-fruit and spice notes. Very good quality Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon was made thanks to our significant holdings of prime terra rossa vineyards from which we were able to judiciously select the very best fruit on offer. The result is a wine that, while elegant and restrained,



has the characteristic ageability for which Black Label Cabernet has become known.

Sarah Pidgeon's favourite from this release is the Michael Shiraz. She believes that, with age, the fine tannins and fragrant fruit will shift into a silky and complex wine. For our senior viticulturist Allen, it's all about wines that are expressions of the vineyards that we nurture. The 2017 Wynns Black Label Cabernet is the quintessential Coonawarra Cabernet for him.

I would like to make special note of the Single Vineyard O'Deas Red Blend. From a site known locally as 'The Hobbit', due to its distinctive big footed vines, this is the very first time we have released a field blend of classically Bordeaux varieties. It represents something very different for us at Wynns that was only possible due to unusually even ripening of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Merlot fruit across the vineyard. This very special single vineyard offering is my pick of the 2019 Wynnsday release.
