

# INTRODUCING THE WYNNSDAY 2023 LUXURY RELEASE

We are pleased to present your 2023 Wynns Luxury Release wine plan, featuring six elegant, medium-bodied Coonawarra red wines from the outstanding 2021, 2020 and 2018 vintages.

In this collection we have included four wines from the recently released Wynnsday 2023 Luxury Release, headlined by the 66th vintage of one of Australia's most cellared wines, Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon. The Glengyle Vineyard north of V&A Lane has made a return, previously featured as the single vineyard release in 2007, 2009 and now in 2021. You'll also find two wines crafted by Sarah Pidgeon; the finely-structured, early picked Cabernet and Cabernet Shiraz from the Wynns V&A Lane Vineyards.

Additionally, we have included an exclusive pre-release of the flagship 2020 John Riddoch Cabernet Sauvignon. With limited availability, this spectacular wine has been reserved for Wynns Luxury Release wine plan members only, and will not be available to other members of CellarDoor.co.

Rounding out this year's Wynns Luxury Release wine plan is the flagship Shiraz, 2018 Michael. This wine is the pinnacle of its style and is already expressive with five years of maturation.

### WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE

#### John Riddoch Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

The Region: Coonawarra, SA

The Aromatics: Notably lifted and intense aromatics. Black olive, raspberry, dried bay leaf, musky notes/red licorice, blue flower/violets; brambles or crushed raspberry leaf. Initially subdued but opens up gradually.

The Flavours: Medium bodied with balanced powdery tannins. Baked plum cake and gentle spices, light pastry notes, green olive. Rhubarb and roasted cherry flavours are persistent on the palate. The fruit is concentrated but not heavy. A wine of poise and elegance.

**The Longevity:** Enjoy today, or cellar carefully for up to 30 years.

**Pair With:** Lamb tagine with artichoke hearts.

### Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

The Region: Coonawarra, SA

The Aromatics: There is a great volume of aromatics here for such a young Cabernet. Redcurrant bun, classic cassis, red cherry with some pleasant earthy and savoury depth pushing the fruits notes up. Chocolate, almond and honeycomb notes complement the fruit notes.

The Flavours: Plush fruit up front, even and wide across the palate, but not overwhelming. Raspberry and plum are complemented by subtle fragrant oak at the back palate, leading to a clean fine finish.

**The Longevity:** Enjoy today, or cellar carefully for 10+ years.

**Pair With:** Hoisin glazed baked salmon with wilted greens.

#### V&A Lane Shiraz 2021

The Region: Coonawarra, SA

**The Aromatics:** Roasted strawberry, magnolia flower and fresh pastry notes. The 50% whole bunches retained in ferment enhance the cool climate florals to next level.

The Flavours: Bright cherry and blueberry complement more savoury elements of stalks, pastry, and spice. There is a light yet expansive quality to the palate. The pure fruits flow through to lingering crushed pepper and a biscuity finish.

**The Longevity:** Enjoy today, or cellar carefully for up to 10 years.

Pair With: Korean vegetable pancake with brown vinegar dipping sauce and kimchi.

#### V&A Lane Cabernet Shiraz 2021

The Region: Coonawarra, SA

The Aromatics: There are red apple blossoms, mulberry, raspberry and white pepper notes. A pleasant dusty spice and a hint of bay leaf gives an overall harmony and restraint to the aromas

The Flavours: There is a weightless feel to the palate without compromise to intensity. A mix of forest berries, black tea and aniseed plays on the palate. The texture is lightly powdery and persistent, with the gentle tannins adding length. All this meshes beautifully with perfectly balanced acidity ensuring a seamless fresh note in the wine right to the end.

**The Longevity:** Enjoy today, or cellar carefully for up to 15 years.

Pair With: Southern Thai yellow coconut crab curry with betel leaf.

#### Glengyle Single Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

The Region: Coonawarra, SA

**The Aromatics:** Dusty cocoa, dill and brambly notes meshing with red berries.

The Flavours: The flavours are beautifully fresh, echoing crunchy red berries and intriguing gentle florals. This wine is finely polished and focused in structure, with great persistence and intensity giving the impression of a wine that is layered, flowing and building all at once. A true wine of stature.

**The Longevity:** Enjoy today, or cellar carefully for 10+ years.

**Pair with:** Charcoal grilled beef short ribs with brown butter sauce.

### WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE

#### Michael Shiraz 2018

The Region: Coonawarra, SA

**The Aromatics:** Lifted aromas of blueberries with hints of bay leaf. There's also a support of orange blossom, lavender and subtle spice.

The Flavours: Layers of red cherries are peppered with dark spice and subtle cloves that build in intensity along the palate. The quality of the 2018 Michael is apparent through the length of the palate and the texture which is already silky but will continue to evolve over time.

**The Longevity:** Enjoy today, or cellar carefully for up to 20 years.

**Pair With:** A delicious Greek mezze platter.
