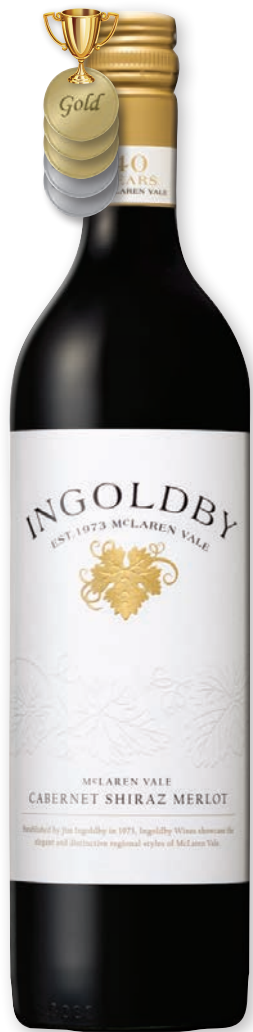

## SPOTLIGHT ON SHIRAZ - AUSTRALIA'S GREAT ENTERTAINER

Australia's most famous wine grape first graced our shores in 1831 and we've not looked back – we even have the world's oldest Shiraz vines still in production. We've made Shiraz distinctly Aussie – but with several personalities to boot – from the Hunter Valley's long-lived earthy and tarry style to the big, bold, rich and famous South Australian wines and a wide array of cooler climate Shiraz from a diversity of regions in between.

Shiraz is the undisputed darling of Australian wine and thrives in good company, especially when blended with Cabernet, Grenache, Merlot, Sangiovese and Tempranillo and Malbec. It also enjoys a perfumed lift when enhanced with Viognier. Vinification techniques vary depending on style and quality; yet whole bunch use has increased but destemming still very common, as is French or combination oaks for maturation delivering complexity – yet, some fresh, early-drinking styles see no oak at all.

Australia's diversity of terroir and climate is reflected in the styles adopted by winemakers. Cooler climate, lighter style Shiraz largely hails from Victoria, the Canberra District and some higher altitude and coastal regions of South Australia. Sometimes referred to as Syrah in nod to the French style, these wines tend to reveal more savoury spice and pepper characters with a finer structure. The renowned warmer climate Shiraz

of the Barossa, McLaren Vale and Clare Valley deliver deeper and richer wines with dark fruit flavours, and secondary chocolate, coffee, liquorice and olive characters.

The ultimate food wine, Shiraz stars in a huge diversity of dishes from red meats, game, charcuterie and spicy cuisine to cheeses and chocolate too. Australia delivers some of the best quality and value quaffing, drink-now Shiraz wines, but is also the variety behind some of Australia's most sought after, collectible fine wines.

Whatever your palate and budget, Shiraz is a stellar investment for entertaining today, and as it boasts a powerful capacity to age, finding your favourite to cellar will see Shiraz continue to reward well into the future.
