The Region: Adelaide Hills, SA

The Aromatics: Fresh and flavours of white cherries and white nectarines dance in harmony with heirloom tomatoes and balsamic for a wonderfully intriguing bouquet.

The Flavours: The palate is all purity, delicacy and precision. Fruits of shredded green papaya, white nectarine and a hint of citrus mesh with steel-cut oats and a light, creamy and savoury edge.

The Flavours: Lemons and limes with spicy ginger and a hint of lemongrass deliver an exotic palate. Textural elements combined with chalky acid result in a wine with balance and delicacy.

The Region: Barossa Valley, SA

The Aromatics: Fragrant, brambly aromas of blackberries, violets, cassis and star anise emanate with lingering hints of savoury spice and a flinty lift.

The Flavours: The plush and mouth-filling palate delivers mulberries, cranberries and redcurrants complemented by chinotto and juniper. Restrained oak gently adds aromatic complexity.

The Aromatics: Classic regional Cabernet aromas of black pastels and cassis dazzle with just a hint of leaf, faint earthy scents and mocha oak.

The Flavours: Medium-bodied, even and balanced, the palate is all about ripe fleshy blackberries, red fruits and mocha flavours with ripe powdery tannins and a persistent finish.

THE ST HUBERTS STORY

Over 150 years ago in Victoria's Yarra Valley, Charles Hubert De Castella began what grew to be one of the largest wine estates in the region. Despite setbacks brought on by the Great Depression, the increasing popularity of fortified wine and the emerging profitability of dairy farming, St Huberts battled and rose again to champion the Valley's wine renaissance and the outstanding reputation that continues today.

From the dizzying heights as Australian wine pioneers winning the Emperor of Germany's Grand Prize at the 1881 Melbourne International Exhibition, and a Grand Prix award at the 1889 Paris Exposition, St Huberts has always been synonymous with outstanding cool climate Cabernet Sauvignon.

In fact, the legacy of global wine show success continues thanks to Greg Jarratt who has been at the winemaking helm since 2006. A Len Evans Tutorial scholar, Greg is a highly sought-after judge at national wine shows – no wonder given the premium portfolio of Chardonnay, Merlot, Pinot Noir and Roussanne he also creates are enjoyed by connoisseurs and critics alike.

No sojourn to the Yarra Valley will miss the beautiful St Huberts Vineyard, which greets visitors at the gateway of the Valley floor nourishing low-yielding crops renowned for intense fruit flavour, depth and concentration. And we think the winery's namesake, St Hubert would be most proud. As patron saint of the hunt, this 7th century nobleman turned his life around after an encounter with a magnificent stag carrying a shining cross between his antlers – and it's a spirit that embodies the much-loved and revered Yarra valley winery.
