SEPPELT ONE MILE DRIVE SHIRAZ 2017

The Accolades: "Great value for a wine with many years to go." *94 points - James Halliday*

The Region: Heathcote, VIC

The Aromatics: Aromas of red, dark and blue fruits with perfumed rose petals, sweet spice and earthy notes.

The Flavours: Concentrated raspberries, spice and dark chocolate characters combine with fine, velvety tannins, fleshy texture and well-integrated cedary oak for an outstanding palate.

WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE BLACK LABEL CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016

The Region: Coonawarra, SA

The Aromatics: Intense and multi-layered aromas fill the glass. It's all about elegant and fragrant dark cherry and blackberry notes enhanced by hints of complex spice.

The Flavours: This is an impressively balanced wine of ripe fruits, black pepper and soft acidity. Polished, fine French oak stretches enhances the brambly notes before a long and smooth finish.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2037

PENFOLDS BIN 23 PINOT NOIR 2018

The Region: Tasmania, Henty, VIC and Adelaide Hills, SA

The Aromatics: An immediate ascent of delicate white strawberry and pastille fruits emanate on the nose before a garnish of fresh thyme flowers and sweet paprika.

The Flavours: This intense, yet lively and fresh medium-bodied Pinot delivers felt-like tannins, with cherries and strawberries inducing a refreshing, mouth-watering grip.

The Longevity: Enjoy now or cellar up to 2024

STERLING VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR CHARDONNAY NV

ANNIE'S LANE CLARE VALLEY RIESLING 2019

The Region: Clare Valley, SA

The Aromatics: This wine delivers a pure and quintessential Clare Valley Riesling bouquet of lime, talc, spice and floral notes filling the glass.

The Flavours: The vibrant palate continue the notes from the nose before finishing with crunchy Granny Smith apples, lime and a chalky mouthfeel.

THE PULL OF A PERFECT PINOT

Sensitive yet temperamental but notoriously thin-skinned and fickle, Pinot Noir is named for the French words for 'pine' and 'black'. Its tightly clustered, pinecone-shaped bunches of fruit make it a difficult variety to cultivate and transform into wine; but when a winemaker's finesse gets Pinot Noir right, the result is pure magic.

Thought to hail from Gouais Blanc, Pinot Noir is a rare variety grown in only a few select areas of France; such a Burgundy and Champagne. Young Pinot beguiles with silky sweet strawberries, cherries and violets; while mature Pinot offers intriguing earthy, forest floor flavours and savoury gaminess. An extra special allure of the Pinot Noir grape is that it's also integral to many Rosé and Sparkling wines and iconic Champagnes.

The very best Pinots in the world, the earthy and floral Grands Crus of Burgundy, are made in minute quantities and command dizzying prices; but you don't have to travel too far from home to enjoy a stellar Pinot. In Australia, the variety flourishes best in our temperate and cooler viticultural regions such as the Yarra Valley, Tasmania, Adelaide Hills and Mornington Peninsula. And these winemakers sure know what we're doing with Pinot. They've had plenty of practice taming its temper – we've been growing the variety that James Halliday calls the 'nectar of the gods' since the 1830s.

From pork, chicken, pheasant and quail to beef, salmon, charcuterie, pâte and terrines; the early-ripening, heavily perfumed Pinot proves to be a decadent companion on the dinner table thanks to its it's higher high acidity, lower tannin profile and smooth finish. But perhaps its most popular pairing is with duck and mushroom dishes. Our choice? The Penfolds Bin 23 Pinot Noir 2018 from this collection with a duck, mushroom and red wine ragout – a perfect winter dining experience.
