





THE ESTATE THAT MADE COONAWARRA FAMOUS

V&A Lane Shiraz 2014

V&A Lane is a long, straight road on the Wynns property that dissects Coonawarra's famous terra rossa strip at its midpoint. Surveyed in 1851, the lane divides the original electorates of Victoria and Albert. Traditionally, the road has been used as a landmark to separate northern and southern vineyards in Coonawarra, as well as being a prestigious and sought-after location for growing exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz grapes.

This wine honours Wynns' prized vineyards along the V & A Lane. The distinctive fruit from these vineyards has a signature density and richness. The mature Shiraz vineyards along V&A Lane ripen early, and are among the first picked each season. The resulting wines have a modern appeal being fresh and spicy, yet still maintaining a succulent and silky Shiraz that can proudly play on the world stage.

Colour

Bright crimson hue.

Nose

Lifted aromas of blueberries, dusty cacao, sweet and sour pastry, layered by hints of fresh tar and black rose.

Palate

Crunchy wild cranberries and bright blueberries are reigned in with layers of savoury stalks, pastry and hints of spice. Silky tannin add depth and tone, guiding the essence of the fruit through the palate, leaving subtleties of crushed pepper and cinnamon spice notes on the finish.
