


19 Crimes.

PINOT NOIR



This punishment by 'transportation' began in 1788, and many of the lawless died at sea. For the rough-hewn prisoners who made it to shore, a new world awaited. As pioneers in a frontier penal colony, they forged a new country and new lives, brick by brick.

This wine is borne of the rules they broke and the culture they built. And like our legendary rogues, it's a taste that'll live forever in infamy.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: medium intense burgundy with a youthful purple rim.

Nose: lifted notes of cherry and strawberry fruit complement rich vanillin overtones, giving warm and inviting aromas.

Palate: medium-bodied with soft, round tannins, cherry and strawberry fruit sweetness which complements the vanilla and spice oak undertones. All these elements combined create a well-balanced, enjoyable wine with a long finish.

WINE DETAILS

Vineyard Region: South Eastern Australia.

Grape Variety: Pinot Noir.

Maturation: 100% American oak.
