The story behind Fifth Leg goes a little like this... Not far from the Devil's Lair winery in Margaret River there is a legendary cave with the same name. During some archaeological digging the fossilised remains of a Tasmanian tiger were found, together with a mysterious fifth leg.

The Fifth Leg Rose has an abundance of primary strawberry and raspberry characters, with crunchy acidity and a savoury edge that keeps everything in balance and adds complexity. Enjoy as an aperitif, with Spanish tapas, Italian and Middle Eastern cuisine – it's ideal where there is plenty of bread to break and food to enjoy.

Region: Western Australia

Maturation: Stainless Steel

Colour: Salmon with a subtle copper hue.

Nose: Musk, cherry and pink grapefruit.

Palate: Succulent summer fruits pink grapefruit and strawberry flan. A dry style of rose that will be a perfect complement with many food summer Mediterranean dishes.
