



Limestone Coast Merlot

The original Jamiesons Run was a remote outback sheep station owned by the Jamieson Brothers in the mid-1800s. The winery was named after the siblings as a tribute to the Limestone Coast's pioneering past.

Since the early 1950s Jamiesons Run has been crafting fruit with a winemaking focus that starts in the vineyard.

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Winemaker Comments

Grape Variety: Merlot

Vineyard Region: Limestone Coast, South Australia

Colour: Dark crimson with brilliant red hues.

Nose: Fragrant red berry fruit aromas with a hint of lifted sweet cedar oak.

Palate: Generous strawberry, raspberry and cherry characters meld with freshly poached plum and blackcurrant fruit. The palate is a supple and silky in texture, the fine velvety and slightly savoury tannins rounding out the finish. A medium bodied Merlot of good depth of flavour, delicate soft supple structure, made in a rounded and generous easy to drink wine style.

Maturation: This wine was matured with Hungarian, French and American oak to add depth and complexity.

Cellaring potential: Made to drink now.
