



Chardonnay

The story behind Fifth Leg goes a little like this... Not far from the Devil's Lair winery in Margaret River there is a legendary cave with the same name. During some archaeological digging the fossilised remains of a Tasmanian tiger were found, together with a mysterious fifth leg.

The Fifth Leg Chardonnay is a crisp, refreshing wine with supple texture and balance. It's a wine full of zesty citrus, vibrant stone fruits and subtle toasty notes.

Winemaker Comments

Grape Variety: Chardonnay

Vineyard Region: Western Australia

Maturation: Stainless Steel

Colour: Bright, pale yellow.

Nose: White tangerine and pink grapefruit blossom. Subtle toast and vanilla with a citrus twist lift.

Palate: Vibrant stone fruit, melon and pear flavours with a clean citrus freshness. Generous and richly flavoured with a delicate crème brioche layer.

Peak Drinking: Enjoy on release or with careful cellaring for 2 to 3 years.

Food Match: Cider braised chicken, or roasted barramundi.
