Grape Variety

Pinot Noir (33%), Grenache (33%). Sangiovese (30%), Shiraz (4%).

Maturation

Selected parcels were picked at optimal ripeness and then cool fermented to preserve freshness and bright flavours.

Colour

Delicate salmon pink.

Nose

A fresh amalgam of red berries and dark currents, Lifted, crisp and perfumed.

Palate

The palate is clean and vibrant displaying delicious flavours of cranberry, pomegranate and strawberry. Delicious fruited mid palate is balanced with a natural crisp finish
