


TEMPRANILLO

This wine is borne of the rules they broke and the culture they built. Imported from abroad like our legendary rogues, it's a taste that'll live forever in infamy.



Colour: Deep red with crimson hues.

Nose: Pepper, warm spice, plum and red currants with lifted vanilla aromatics.

Palate: Plush and full, with a subtle vanilla sweetness giving rich mouthfeel. The palate is filled with dark fruits with a hint of spice. Medium-full bodied red wine.

Vineyard Region: Spain.

Grape Variety: Tempranillo. **Maturation**: American oak.
