


## SAUVIGNON BLOCK

This wine is borne of the rules they broke and the culture they built. And like our legendary rogues, it's a taste that'll live forever in infamy.

## TASTING NOTE

Colour: light straw.

Nose: lifted aromas of passionfruit, grapefruit, gooseberry, and guava.

Palate: light-bodied, with a fresh, crisp finish. A criminally easy wine to enjoy in many ways.

## WINE DETAILS

Vineyard Region: South Eastern Australia.

Grape Variety: Sauvignon Blanc.

Maturation: stainless steel.
