WINEMAKER COMMENTS DOM COULTER

VINTAGE CONDITIONS: Abundant winter rainfall preceded a burst of warm spring sunshine and ideal summer weather. Excellent flowering conditions promoted naturally balanced vine canopies showing great promise. A brief top up of rain in late January ensured the grapes continued to build flavour and fruited tannin through March and April. Autumn was characterised by ideal warm days and cool nights. Cabernets showed supple tannins, perfumed elegance and a generous savoury texture.

GRAPE VARIETY: Cabernet Sauvignon

COLOUR: Rich garnet and ruby

NOSE: Classic Margaret River Cabernet. Cassis, mulberry and logan berries with polished cedar and regional bay leaf

PALATE: Bright punchy cassis and red fruits with supple rounded tannins driving a long and pleasing finish. Classic cabernet structure and medium bodied, this wine while drinking beautifully now will age gracefully for many years
