

This wine is borne of the rules they broke and the culture they built. And like our legendary rogues, it's a taste that'll live forever in infamy.



Colour: bright red to crimson hues.

Nose: intense lifted vanilla aromatics balanced with ripe red to dark berry fruits.

Palate: full and round on the palate with a distinct sweetness giving a rich and round mouth feel. The vanilla aromatics carry through and compliment flavours of chocolate and cedary spice, finishing with a pleasant lingering freshness.

WINE DETAILS

Vineyard Region: South Eastern Australia. Grape Variety: Shiraz-dominant blend.

Maturation: 100% American oak.
