Colour

Light straw.

Nose

The nose is totally delicious smelling brimming with aromas of delicate pear, nectarine, and lemon tart, with perfumed white flowers.

Palate

The palate is ridiculously fruity ripe and concentrated, bursting with freshly picked nectarine, nashi pear flavours, and a hint of honeysuckle. With a creamy mouthfeel flowing to a subtle sweet finish, this is a wine that will knock your trots off delicately lush and structured Pinot Gris that will leave you squealing for more!

Cellaring

This wine should be enjoyed while the juicy fruit flavours are still vibrant and fresh, so as soon as possible within 2 years of bottling.
