Coldstream Hills prides itself for having access to many of the best vineyards in the Yarra Valley. These sites are found throughout the upper and lower Yarra Valley with each vineyard providing a range of unique characteristics to the wines.

The Hills Chardonnay has attractive notes of honeydew melon, white peach and white flowers. The palate is fine and balanced with juicy grape acidity, delicious stone-fruit flavours, texture and length.

Matured in seasoned and new French oak.

Peak Drinking

Enjoy on release or with one to two years of careful cellaring.

Food Matching

Perfect with prosciutto-wrapped chicken, or pumpkin ravioli with sage burnt butter.

Colour

Pale straw.

Bouquet

Attractive notes of honeydew melon, white peach and hints of white flowers. Nougat and subtle French oak add complexity.

Palate

Fine and balanced with juicy grape acidity. Attractive stone-fruit characters and quince are evident, producing a wine with flavour, texture and length.
