

This punishment by 'transportation' began in 1788, and many of the lawless died at sea. For the rough-hewn prisoners who made it to shore, a new world awaited. As pioneers in a frontier penal colony, they forged a new country and new lives, brick by brick.

This wine is borne of the rules they broke and the culture they built. Imported from abroad like our legendary rogues, it's a taste that'll live forever in infamy.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: bright red to crimson hues.

Nose: violets, red currants and mulberries with lifted vanilla aromatics.

Palate: firm and full, with a subtle vanilla sweetness giving a rich mouth feel. The palate is filled with dark cherry fruit, red currants, and chocolate, and the soft tannins provide a lingering finish.

WINE DETAILS

Vineyard Region: Mendoza, Argentina.

Grape Variety: Malbec.

Maturation: 100% American oak.
